

It is a prime intention of the conference to provide the maximum opportunity for interaction between chemists from industry, universities and government organisations. There will be no publication of abstracts or proceedings.





Travel Information

Travel to Bowral is best by road or rail. Plan to arrive mid afternoon in time for the opening plenary lecture at 3.30pm.

If travelling by car from Sydney, proceed south and turn off the Hume Highway (M31) at Mittagong (ca 75 min). Proceed along State Route 79 to Bowral, approx. 8 km from the traffic lights at the Mittagong turnoff. Follow State Route 79 (Bowral Rd) for 3.4 km then turn right on to Lyle Ave, and after 600 m turn at the first right on to Centennial Rd. After another 700 m, turn right at Boronia St, and as the street veers left (100 m), proceed straight ahead, past the Golfview Lodge, and follow the signs to the Gibraltar Hotel. The hotel building is large and vehicle parking is available at the entrance.

From Melbourne or Canberra, proceed north along the Hume Highway (31), past Goulburn, and leave the Highway at State Road 89, the exit towards Berrima, after 400 m turn right onto Mereworth Rd, then follow the Old Hume. Highway for 9.8 km, through one roundabout. Turn right at Centennial Rd and after 3.5 km turn left at Boronia St. As the street veers left (100 m), proceed straight ahead, past the Golfview Lodge, and follow the signs to the Gibraltar Hotel.

Trains run from Sydney's Central Station to Bowral. Transport from Bowral station to the hotel can be arranged if rail travellers mark their registration form accordingly.
